The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a contract to Roadway Construction, LLC. for improvements to SR 811 / NE 4 Avenue / Wilton Drive in Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors.

The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward. This project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency that is responsible for making decisions on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend federal funds on transportation projects within Broward. PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway
- Upgrading signs and pavement markings
- Adding a buffered bike lane in each direction
- Widening sidewalks, upgrading pedestrian signals and modifying pedestrian curb ramps to meet ADA requirements
- Upgrading roadway and pedestrian lighting
- Installing new drainage structures and upgrading the existing drainage system

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- One lane in each direction may be closed at any time within the project limits.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of the street at all times.
- Additional information about lane closures will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
