NW 136TH AVENUE AT SR 84 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Construction Open House regarding the improvements of NW 136th Avenue at SR 84, near the I-595 interchange. The project is located within the cities of Davie, Plantation, and Sunrise. Representatives from the FDOT and project partners will be available to answer your questions. This meeting will have an informal open house format; no formal presentation will be made. Construction plans will be available for public viewing.

MAJOR PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing and widening the existing bridge over the North New River Canal, resulting in an additional southbound through lane and designated bike lanes.
- Adding a designated right-turn lane from westbound SR 84 to northbound NW 136th Avenue.
- Upgrading existing lighting to LED.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- During the replacement of the bridge, traffic will be reduced to 2 lanes in each direction as shown in the configuration below:



- Single lane closures may occur overnight, Sunday through Thursday, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Additional lane closure and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
