SR 93/I-75 RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, has awarded a contract to Halley Engineering, Inc. for resurfacing improvements along SR 93/I-75 from the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line to north of Sheridan Street in Miramar and Pembroke Pines.

Construction Cost: \$8.5 million

Construction Start Date: July 22, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing along SR 93/I-75 from the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line to north of Sheridan Street.
- Installing double-face guardrail between the General Use Lanes and Managed Lanes.

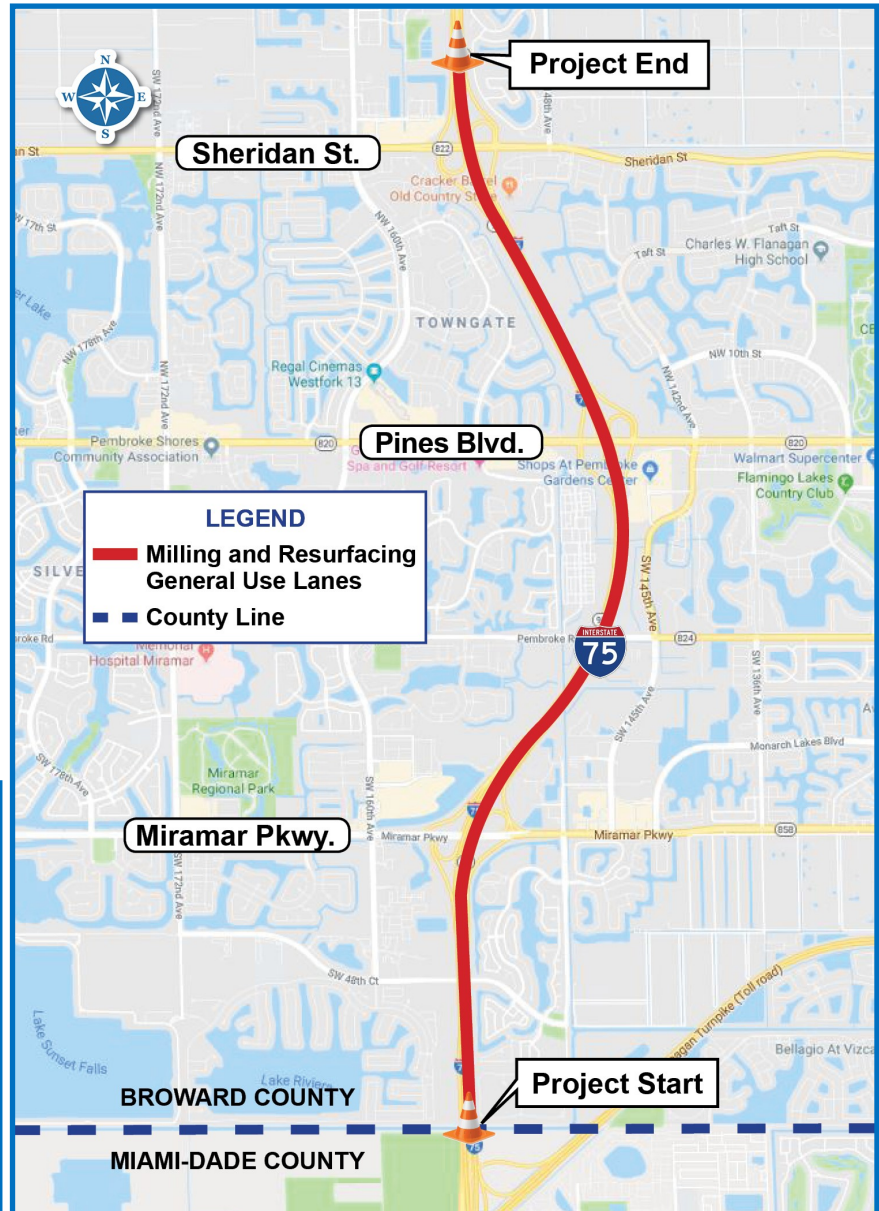
TRAFFIC IMPACT

- Lane closures on SR 93/I-75 are permitted between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night. One lane of SR 93/I-75 can close at 9:00 p.m., two lanes can close at 10:30 p.m., and three lanes can close at 12:30 a.m., until 5:30 a.m. Access to the Managed Lanes may be impacted during these closures.
- SR 93/I-75 entrance and exit ramp closures are permitted between 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night.
- Additional information about lane closures and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
