



A1A LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM OAKLAND PARK BOULEVARD TO FLAMINGO AVENUE IN FORT LAUDERDALE

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) awarded a \$1,225,731 contract to Landscape Service Professionals, Inc. for improvements along A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale. Construction began April 24, 2018 and will be completed in fall 2018.

Project Improvements

- Installing a new irrigation system in the median and along both sides of the road
- Installing plants in the median and along both sides of the road including various species of palms, shade trees and shrubs

Traffic Impact

- The existing 35 mph speed limit will remain in effect during construction.
- Single lane closures can be expected Mondays through Fridays between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Sidewalk areas will be maintained on at least one side of the road within the project limits. Signage will be in place to guide pedestrians.

Maintenance

Upon completion of the installation (construction) phase of the project in fall 2018, the contractor will maintain the irrigation and landscaping within the corridor for two years before transferring the maintenance to the City of Fort Lauderdale.
