



Flagler Memorial Bridge Replacement Project Update **Friday, March 9, 2018**

Please be advised Flagler Memorial Bridge, Quadrille Boulevard between Olive Avenue and Flagler Drive, and Flagler Drive between Fourth Street and Seventh Street will have intermittent single-lane closures from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily from Monday, March 12, to Friday, March 16. Flaggers will maintain traffic in the remaining open lanes as milling and resurfacing is performed on the roadways.

In addition, Flagler Memorial Bridge will have intermittent single-lane closures from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily from Monday, March 19, to Tuesday, March 20. Parking on the east side of the bridge adjacent to Bradley Park will be temporarily unavailable during this time. Flaggers will maintain traffic in the remaining lanes as milling and resurfacing is performed.

The Flagler Memorial Bridge Replacement Project replaced the 75-year-old bascule (draw) bridge with a new bascule bridge connecting the Town of Palm Beach and the City of West Palm Beach over the Lake Worth Lagoon and the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW). The Flagler Drive overpass was replaced with an “at-grade” intersection. New lighting, traffic signals, drainage, and landscaping are also included. Active construction began on Sept. 10, 2012, and will last until spring 2018. The estimated construction cost is \$107 million.
