SR 80/SOUTHERN BOULEVARD AT FOREST HILL BOULEVARD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

This 0.46-mile intersection improvement project, located in Royal Palm Beach and Wellington, consists of adding a third westbound to southbound left-turn lane from SR 80 to Forest Hill Boulevard, widening the bridge over the C-51 Canal, converting the Forest Hill Boulevard northbound right-turn lanes to a free-flowing right-turn lane, and widening Southern Boulevard to accommodate an eastbound acceleration lane. Other improvements include milling and resurfacing, drainage, curb and gutter, lighting, guardrails, signalization, sidewalks, landscaping, signage and pavement markings.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Please see below anticipated work (weather permitting) through August 10:

- Widening the west side of the Forest Hill Boulevard bridge
- Installing irrigation
- Installing lighting along eastbound and westbound Southern Boulevard
- Installing fiber optic line
- Installing railing on the bridge and traffic wall on the east side of Forest Hill Boulevard

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- Southern Boulevard’s north sidewalk from Crestwood Boulevard to Royal Palm Beach Boulevard is closed until further notice.
- Forest Hill Boulevard’s west sidewalk is closed from Southern Boulevard to Quercus Lane until further notice.

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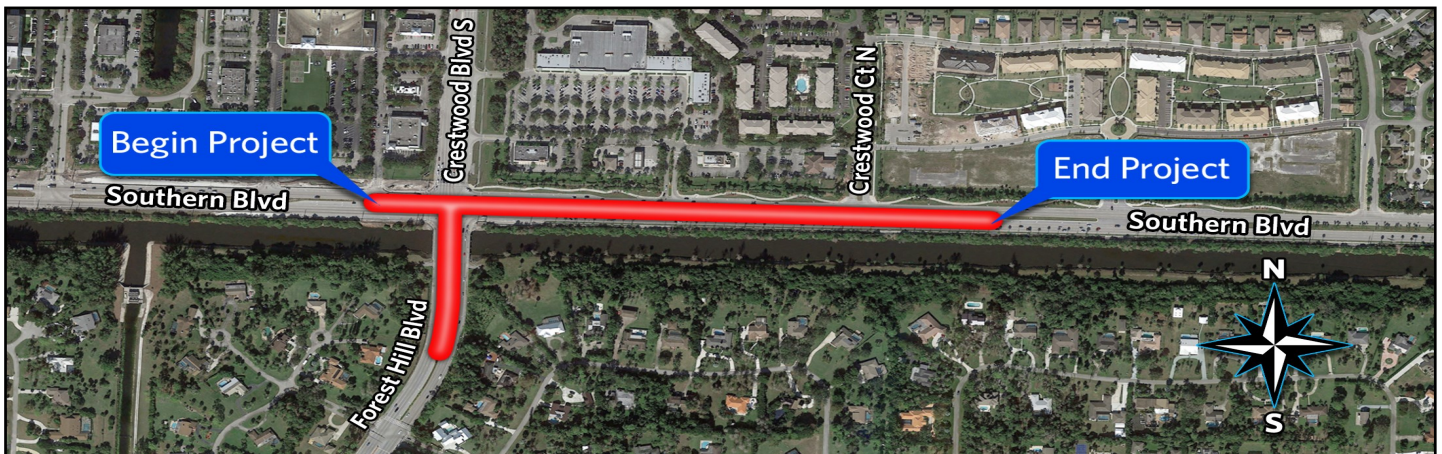
