On Tuesday, Sept. 26, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the ITS (Intelligent Transportation System) improvements project on Glades Road, between State Road 7/US 441 and State Road 5/US 1, in Boca Raton, at the Mission Bay Community Clubhouse, 10555 Diego Drive South, Boca Raton, FL, 33428.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, schedule, related lane closures, and address questions and comments one-on-one. Please note: There will not be a formal presentation. Guests may arrive at any time between 4 and 6 p.m.

This 7.3-mile ITS project will begin Monday, Sept. 18, 2017 and is expected to be completed late summer 2018, weather permitting. The project cost is \$3.5 million. Work is being performed by Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., with FDOT overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Widening, milling and resurfacing portions of the roadway
- The addition of left-turn lanes on State Road 7/US 441
- Guardrail, sidewalk, driveway and drainage improvements
- ITS and fiber optic cable installation
- Pedestrian and mast arm signalization, vehicle detection systems, lighting, signage and pavement marking upgrades

Maintenance of Traffic:

In order to do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at various times and locations daily and nightly. Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts on the community and motoring public.

Project-related lane closures can be expected at these locations during these timeframes: Glades Road, 10 p.m. until 7 a.m.; State Road 7/US 441, 9:30 p.m. until 7 a.m.; I-95 NB exit ramp, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.; US 1/State Road 5, 8 p.m. until 8 a.m.; NW 13th St./East University Drive, 9 a.m. until 4 p.m.; NW 4th Avenue, 9 a.m. until 4 p.m.; and, Dixie Highway, 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. Monday through Friday only.
