The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-person Construction Open House regarding upcoming improvements to SR 809/Military Trail from south of Dyer Boulevard to north of Flag Drive in the City of Riviera Beach. Construction Cost: \$2.6 million Construction Start: August 2023 Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway.
- Reconstructing sidewalks in select locations.
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- Upgrading signalization at Dyer Boulevard, SR 710/ Beeline Highway/Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, and SR 708/W Blue Heron Boulevard.
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, intersection lighting, signage, and pavement markings.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public.
- Single-lane closures are allowed in the project area at all times, except within 600 feet of intersections where closures are permitted from 7:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.
- Double-lane closures are permitted nightly from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk construction as needed.
- Pedestrian, driveway and street access will be maintained at all times.


