"Jobs Express Terminal" Gatlin Boulevard Park and Ride Lot Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will begin the "Jobs Express Terminal" Gatlin Boulevard park and ride lot project just east of the I-95 interchange, between Brescia Street and Edgarce Street, in St. Lucie County on August 23, 2020. The purpose of the project is to support regional commuter trips to and from the greater St. Lucie County area. The contractor is Hardrives of Delray, Inc., and FDOT will be overseeing the project.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a park and ride lot with the capacity to hold 162 vehicles
- Constructing a connection to the existing access road for the Gatlin Plaza shopping complex
- Installing bus shelters for six simultaneous buses for drop-off or pick-up
- Installing pedestrian level lighting and landscaping
- Installing drainage with on-site storm water detention


TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the traveling public. Single lane closures will occur on SW Gatlin Boulevard and SW Hayworth Avenue Monday through Friday except for during the peak hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. When lane closures are occurring on SW Hayworth Avenue, two-way traffic will be maintained by a flag crew.

Nighttime single lane closures will occur on SW Brescia Street Sunday through Thursday night between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Lane closures on SW Hayworth Avenue and SW Brescia Street will not be permitted from November 1st through December 31st.

Sidewalk impacts will occur on SW Gatlin Boulevard and SW Brescia Street. Pedestrian traffic will be diverted via a temporary sidewalk, and at times pedestrian traffic on SW Gatlin Boulevard will be detoured to the nearest signalized intersections.
