
State Road (SR) 700/Conners Highway Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation Project

SR 700/CONNERS HIGHWAY WILL BE CLOSED FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORK JULY 6 THROUGH OCT. 31

Beginning at 12:01 a.m., Sunday, July 6, all lanes of SR 700/Conners Highway, from Hatton Highway to SR 717/Muck City Road will be closed around-the-clock through approximately 5 p.m., Friday, Oct. 31, for roadway widening, milling & repaving, installing pavement markings, signs, guardrail, rumble strips, and sod.

To ensure motorist and crew safety during this full closure the following detour routes will be implemented:

- Northbound SR 700/Conners Highway will be detoured via Hatton Highway, SR 80/US 441, N Main Street/US 441/US 98/SR 15, SR 717/Muck City Road to northbound SR 700/Conners Highway.
- Southbound SR 700/Conners Highway will be detoured via SR 717/Muck City Road, N Main Street/US 441/US 98/SR 15, and SR 80/US 441, Hatton Highway to southbound SR 700/Conners Highway. Motorists can also continue westbound on SR 80/US 441 to continue southbound on SR 700/Conners Highway.
- Emergency/First Responder access and local access will be maintained and coordinated.
