SR 804/East Ocean Avenue Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 804/East Ocean Avenue Resurfacing Project in the City of Boynton Beach and the Town of Ocean Ridge. This project aims to enhance the technology, safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure in our communities.

Construction Cost: \$1.3 Million

Construction Start: March 2025

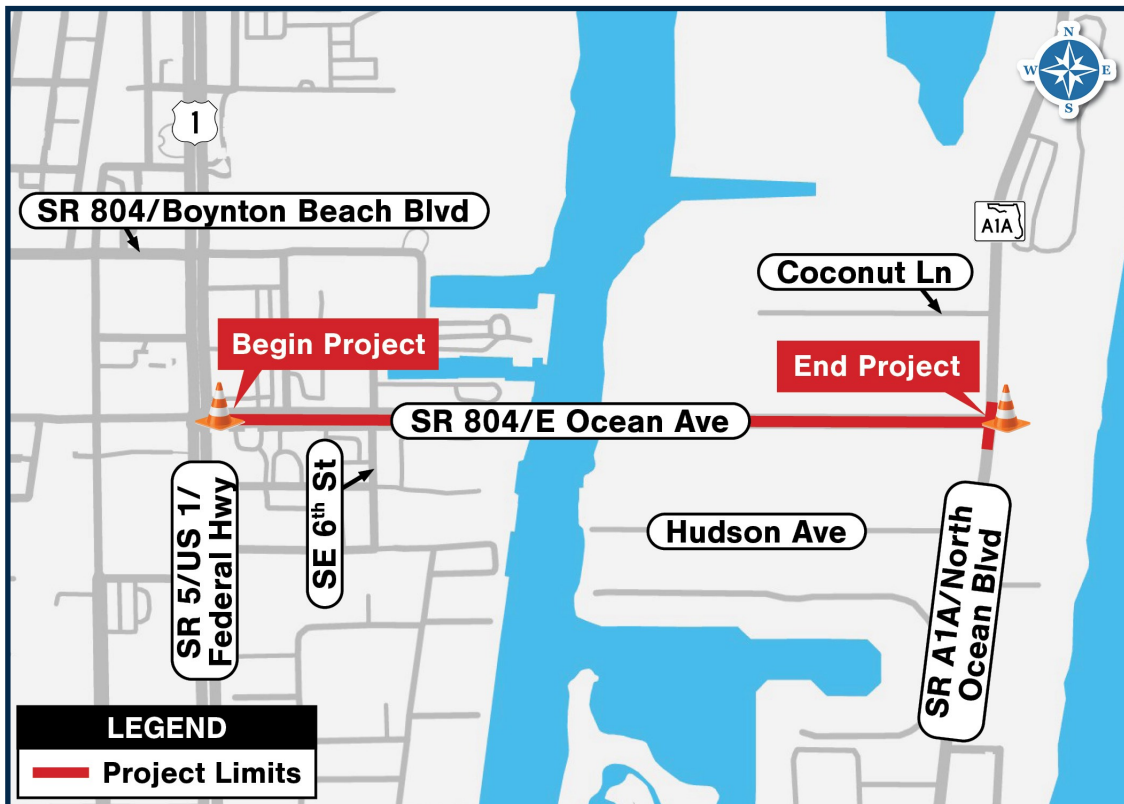
Estimated Completion: Late 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience and safety
- Upgrading curb ramps and replacing sections of the existing sidewalk within the project limits to enhance pedestrian safety and connectivity
- Upgrading pedestrian signals at SR A1A/North Ocean Boulevard and installing Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB's) at the NE 6th Street crosswalk to enhance pedestrian safety
- Installing LED lighting at NE 6th Street and at SR A1A/North Ocean Boulevard to enhance pedestrian safety and visibility
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings, including bicycle markings, to enhance visibility and safety for both motorists and cyclists

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- Lane closures are permitted daily and will utilize flaggers to direct traffic as needed
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained at all times through detours aligned with construction phasing
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
