MID-OCT. 2024 PROGRESS UPDATE — COUNTDOWN TO PARTIAL BRIDGE OPENING!

Saturday, October 19, 2024 marks day 1098 of 1545, with 71% completed. Crews are working 7 days a week to open one lane of traffic in each direction by Early 2025. Please see below for major milestones to accomplish before placing traffic on the bridge. Activities will proceed in this general order over the following months until the bridge is ready for partial opening. MILESTONES TO OPEN THE WESTERN SIDE OF BRIDGE TO TRAFFIC

POUR CONCRETE DECK FOR SPAN 5, north side of bascule bridge — OCTOBER 2024

PAVE THE BRIDGE APPROACHES, south side then north side of project — OCTOBER 2024

POUR CONCRETE DECK ON BASCULE BRIDGE, northwest leaf then southwest leaf — NOVEMBER 2024

SHIFT BOAT TRAFFIC INTO THE MAIN CHANNEL, under the bascule bridge — NOVEMBER 2024

SET BEAMS FOR SPAN 3, south side of bascule bridge — **NOVEMBER 2024**

POUR CONCRETE DECK FOR SPAN 3, south side of bascule bridge — NOVEMBER 2024

COMPLETE BRIDGE INSPECTIONS AND FUNCTIONAL CHECKOUT — DECEMBER 2024

SAFELY OPEN ONE LANE OF TRAFFIC IN EACH DIRECTION ON THE WESTERN SIDE OF THE BRIDGE!

<u>Please note:</u> As weather impacts, material deliveries and unforeseen issues can fluctuate the schedule, updates will be provided as milestones are completed until one lane is open to traffic in each direction.

MAJOR MILESTONES THROUGH REMAINDER OF PROJECT

- Open the eastern side of bridge to traffic in Spring 2025
- Open the Riverwalk connection underneath the south side of bridge in Summer 2025
- Final project completion in Early 2026
