ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR OCTOBER 2024

ROADWAY OPERATIONS

- Phase 1 Maintenance of Traffic: northwest-bound SR 710 traffic has been shifted to the west to allow for outside widening
- Drainage activities ongoing along Blue Heron Blvd and along northwest-bound SR710/Beeline Hwy
- Median clearing ongoing on Northlake Blvd in preparation for placement of temporary pavement
- Reshaping and expansion of the pond at the SR 710/Beeline Highway & Jog Road intersection ongoing (this expanded pond is part of the new drainage system being installed under this contract)
- Placement of concrete for the cast-in-place retaining wall adjacent to Steeplechase ongoing. Earthwork operations to begin against the newly constructed cast-in-place retaining wall
- The SR 710/Beeline Highway westbound access to eastbound Northlake Boulevard has been temporarily shifted to safely facilitate this phase of construction. The current movement is anticipated to reopen in Fall 2025. During this phase, from SR 710/Beeline Highway westbound, motorists can turn right at the intersection to access eastbound Northlake Boulevard.
- The SR 710/Beeline Highway westbound access to eastbound Northlake Boulevard has been temporarily shifted to safely facilitate this phase of construction. The current movement is anticipated to reopen in Fall 2025. During this phase, from SR 710/Beeline Highway westbound, motorists can turn right at the intersection to access eastbound Northlake Boulevard.

BRIDGE OPERATIONS (FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE OVER SR 710)

- Placement of temporary concrete barrier wall and removal of existing median barrier wall ongoing
- Nightly lane closures as needed to facilitate this work

UPCOMING MILESTONES

- Cast-in-place wall construction along Steeplechase to continue in October 2024
- Drainage work on the north side/westbound lanes to continue in October 2024
- Reconstruction of the westbound lanes to continue October 2024
