WESTBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFT ON SR A1A AND CR 605/OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY TO CONTINUE THROUGH LATE 2026

To ensure community and crew safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, the SR A1A and CR 605/Old Dixie Highway intersection was shifted slightly south on Monday, April 28, to facilitate the construction of the west end of the new North Causeway Bridge. **Please note that the traffic lights at the SR A1A and CR 605/Old Dixie Highway intersection will be removed and replaced with a 2-way stop.** Traffic will remain in the new configuration until the new bridge is opened to the public, which is anticipated for Late 2026.

- Westbound SR A1A to northbound and southbound SR 5/US 1 motorists will be detoured via north CR 605/Old Dixie Highway to westbound Juanita Avenue to SR 5/US 1.
- Westbound SR A1A to SR 5/US 1 motorists using Sunny Lane can only go northbound onto SR 5/US 1.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
