### NIGHTTIME PILE DRIVING FOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN JULY 7, 2025

As part of the SR A1A North Causeway Over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) Bridge Replacement Project, nighttime pile driving will take place at the west end of the bridge, near the Florida East Coast (FEC) Railway at SR A1A and County Road (CR) 605/Old Dixie Highway. This activity, shown in the image below, may produce noticeable noise. Given the close proximity to the railroad tracks and safety considerations, pile driving will occur intermittently at night, from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. This schedule will begin on Monday, July 7, 2025, and will continue through Thursday, August 28, 2025, weather permitting. 
