SW PORT ST. LUCIE BOULEVARD WIDENING PROJECT MONTHLY PROGRESS REPORT

As of Thursday, May 1, 2025, the project is 81% complete. The anticipated project completion is Summer 2025. Additional information, flyers, and progress photos can be found on the project webpage.

PROGRESS: APRIL 2025

- Continued with subgrade work and curb pad installation for the new northbound travel lanes
- Closed SW Tulip Boulevard for roadway reconstruction work and continued roadway reconstruction activities at SW Tunis Avenue and SW Thrift Avenue
- Continued with excavation work for the new northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes and placed the first lift of base rock throughout the project limits
- Placed asphalt for the outside median and curb pads along the southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes
- Installed irrigation lines throughout the project limits
- Continued with installing signal and lighting components throughout the project corridor
- Removed existing signs and installed new road signs along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Continued with pond excavation activities
- Installed sod along southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard

ANTICIPATED WORK: MAY 2025

- Continuing subgrade work and curb pad installation for the new northbound travel lanes
- Ongoing excavation of the pond
- Constructing light pole foundations along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Reconstructing SW Tunis Avenue, SW Thrift Avenue, SW Trouville Avenue, and SW Tulip Boulevard will continue throughout May
- Ongoing excavation work for the new northbound SW Port St. Lucie travel lanes
- Placing the first lift of base rock for the new northbound travel lanes throughout the project limits
- Ongoing drainage work throughout the project limits
