PROGRESS: AUGUST 2025

- Finished grading for sod throughout the project limits
- Completed the excavation of the new northbound travel lanes and base rock placement
- Continued grading for sidewalk construction along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard between SW Alcantarra Boulevard and SW Alexandria Avenue
- Continued drainage work throughout the project limits
- Finished placing structural asphalt along SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard and side streets
- Poured concrete for the textured median separator
- Continued pedestrian pole work throughout the project limits
- Continued installation of the new irrigation system
- Placed sod along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard and in the medians
- Continued deficiency repairs throughout the project limits

ANTICIPATED WORK: SEPTEMBER 2025

- Beginning drainage pipe repairs
- Completing light pole installation along southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Completing irrigation work
- Finishing landscaping throughout the project limits
- Placing final friction course asphalt
- Placing final pavement markings throughout the project corridor
- Resuming sign installation work
- Continuing deficiency repairs
