- Continued drainage pipe repairs throughout the project limits
- Completed sign installation throughout the project corridor
- Planted trees in the median
- Completed milling and repaving a section of the roadway at the pond
- Continued cleaning and sealing the median textured concrete throughout the project limits
- Continued deficiency repairs throughout the project limits
- · Painted final roadway edge lines and all planned pavement markings throughout the project corridor
- Continued irrigation work in the median

- Completing drainage pipe repairs
- Completing irrigation work in the median
- Placing final thermoplastic pavement markings throughout the project corridor
- Completing deficiency repairs
