



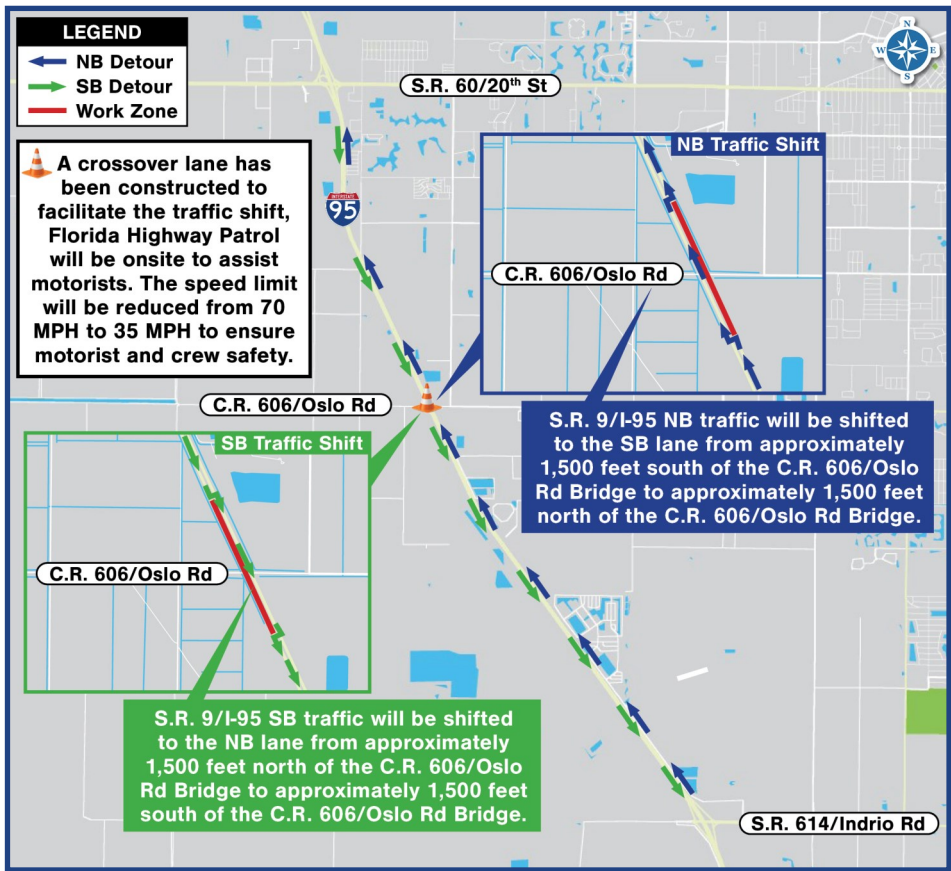

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 at County Road (C.R.) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and C.R. 606/Oslo Road Widening Project

S.R. 9/I-95 NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC TO BE TEMPORARILY SHIFTED NIGHTLY FEB. 9-19, 2026

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, crews will implement a traffic shift by reducing the three-lane section of S.R. 9/I-95 in each direction to one lane between S.R. 614/Indrio Road (Exit 138) and S.R. 60/20th Street (Exit 147). This lane reduction will take place nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday to Thursday, beginning Monday, Feb. 9 through Thursday, Feb. 19, for construction work, excluding Friday and Saturday nights. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained via two constructed crossover lanes to facilitate the traffic shift. This reduction is necessary to safely perform roadway work and construction. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, the shifts will continue through Thursday, Feb. 26.

- Northbound motorists on S.R. 9/I-95 will be shifted to the southbound lanes at C.R. 606/Oslo Road bridge using a new crossover lane during bridge construction work.
- Southbound motorists on S.R. 9/I-95 will be shifted to the northbound lanes at C.R. 606/Oslo Road bridge using a new crossover lane during bridge construction work.
- To ensure motorist and crew safety, the speed limit will be reduced from 70 MPH to 35 MPH. The Florida Highway Patrol will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
