SR 9/I-95 RRR PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 9/I-95 RRR Project in Martin County. The project limits are on SR 9/I-95 from north of CR 708/Bridge Road to the Martin/St. Lucie County line. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$40.8 Million

Construction Start: June 2025

Estimated Completion: Fall 2028

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the SR 9/I-95 mainline from north of CR 708/Bridge Road to the Martin/St. Lucie County line to enhance safety and long-term resiliency.
- Widening the northbound SR 9/I-95 entrance ramp shoulder from SR 76/Kanner Highway to improve safety and traffic operations.
- Constructing new lighting to increase nighttime visibility.
- Installing Wrong Way Vehicle Detection Systems (WWVDS) on SR 76/Kanner Highway, SR 714/Martin Highway, and CR 713/High Meadow Avenue ramps to improve safety.
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings to enhance safety, functionality, and traffic operations.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Lane and interchange ramp closures on SR 9/I-95 are permitted nightly, Sunday through Thursday as follows:

- From north of CR 708/Bridge Road to south of SR 76/Kanner Highway:
 - Single and double lane closures on northbound and southbound SR 9/I-95 from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- From south of SR 76/Kanner Highway to the Martin/St. Lucie County Line:
 - Single and double lane closures on northbound SR 9/I-95, from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
 - Single and double lane closures on southbound SR 9/I-95, from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- SR 9/I-95 ramp impacts:
 - Single lane and full ramp closures are permitted throughout the project limits, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Consecutive ramp closures will not take place at the same time.
