FDOT - State Road (S.R.) 70/Okeechobee Road Resurfacing Project



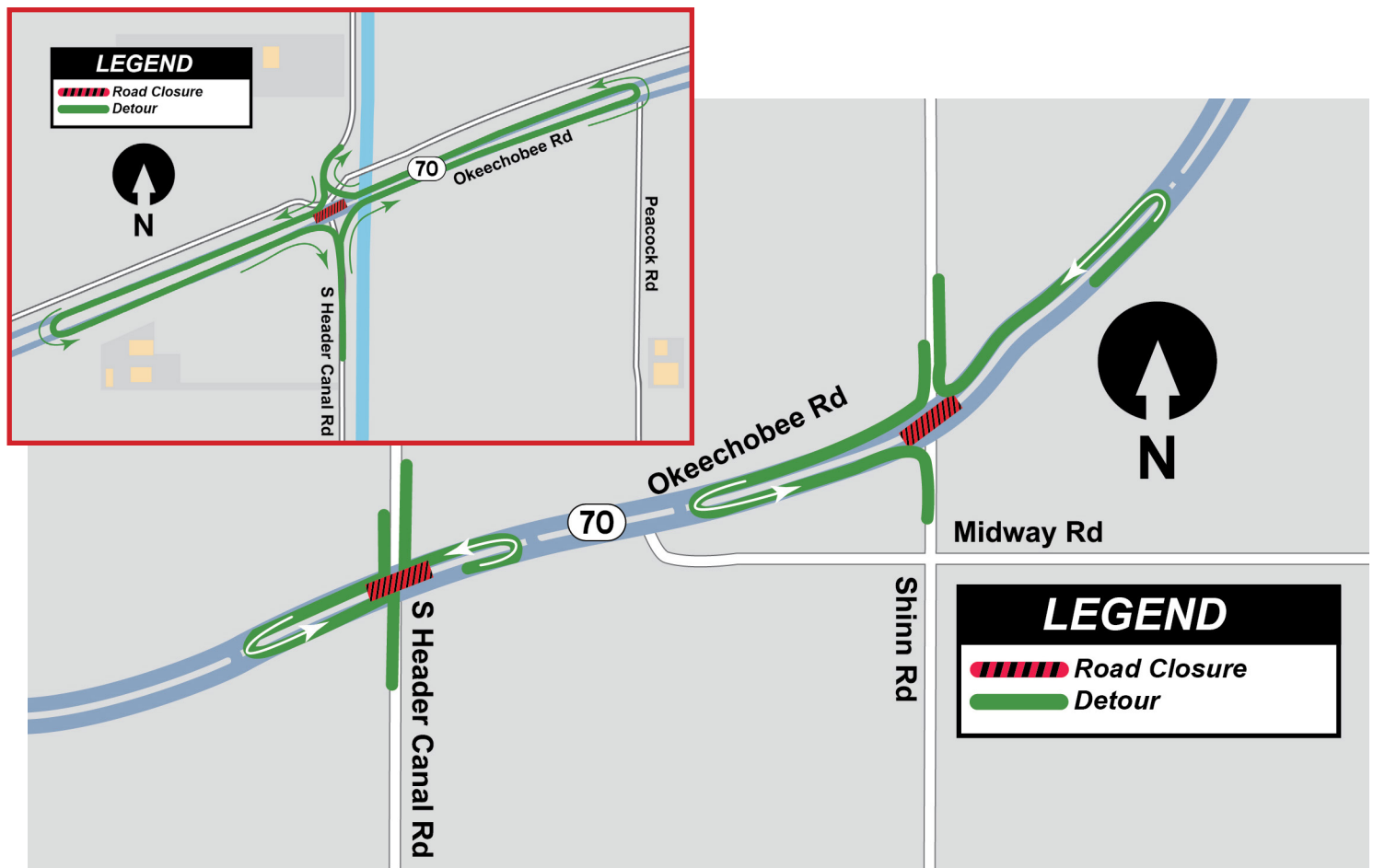
Intersection Closures Extended through to February 15, 2026

OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be upgrading the intersections at S.R. 70/Okeechobee Road & S. Header Canal Road and S.R. 70/Okeechobee Road & Shinn Road into Restricted Crossing U-Turn (RCUT) intersections at each location. This will improve safety and efficiency of the intersections by reducing possible conflict points.

To perform this work safely, the median crossover intersections at both S. Header Canal Road and Shinn Road closed on October 13. The intersections will reopen on February 15, 2026 with a new traffic pattern. Drivers on S.R. 70 will be able to make left turns and U-turns, but left turns from adjacent streets onto S.R. 70 will not be allowed.

Motorists are advised to use the next available U-turn, as shown on the maps below. Detour signage will be clearly posted to guide drivers around the work zone.
