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





## **Project Limits**





### **Project Overview**

<u>Purpose:</u> Construct approximately 4.2 miles of 10-foot (8-feet where constrained) accessible multi-use trail with boardwalk sections. This segment of the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Network will be located within the Savannas Preserve State Park, along roadways, and within the Canal 22 right-of-way.

Length: 4.2 miles

**Contractor:** West Construction, Inc.

Construction Start: July 21, 2024

**Estimated Contract Cost:** \$5.82 Million

**Estimated Completion:** Late 2025

Contract Time: 413 calendar days

(not including weather and holidays)


## East Coast Greenway within St. Lucie County

SUN Trail is part of the bigger plan for St. Lucie County




## Safety Improvements – New Mid-Block Pedestrian Crossings at Easy Street and CR 712/Midway Road



An example of a mid-block pedestrian crossing with a Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacon (RRFB). When activated, the rapidly flashing beacons enhance the visibility of pedestrians at the crossing to motorists.













### **Typical Section – Boardwalk**

#### **Traffic Impacts**

#### **Maintenance of Traffic:**

- Single-lane closures are permitted during the daytime, Monday through Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on the following streets:
  - Easy Street
  - Buchanan Drive
  - Pinetree Drive
  - Palmetto Drive
  - Silver Oak Drive
  - Seagrape Drive
  - Myrtle Drive
  - Sunset Boulevard
  - County Road (CR) 712/Midway Road



#### **Construction Phases**

#### Phase 1:

- Construct mid-block pedestrian crossings on Easy Street and CR 712/Midway Road.
- Construct the shared-use path throughout project limits.





#### **Construction Phases**

#### Phase 2A:

- Mill and resurface Easy Street and CR 712/Midway Road to ensure long-term resilience.
- Install temporary pavement markings on the new surface to enhance visibility and safety for pedestrians.

#### Phase 2B:

 Install final pavement markings on Easy Street and CR 712/Midway Road to improve visibility and safety for motorists and pedestrians.



## Safety and Local Coordination

- Public Safety is our Top Priority!
  - Work Zone Signage & Maintenance of Traffic
    - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public



- The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
- Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times
