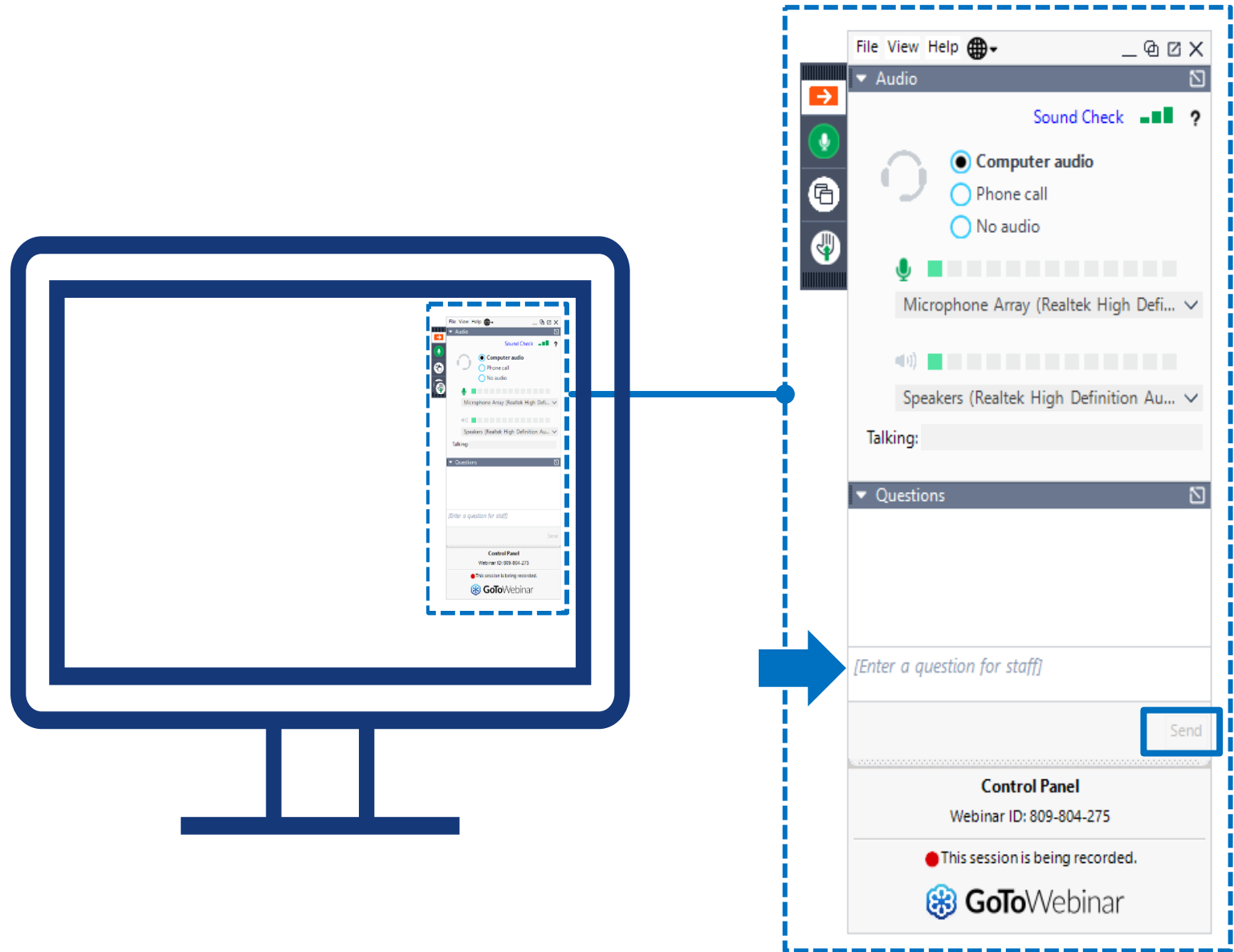

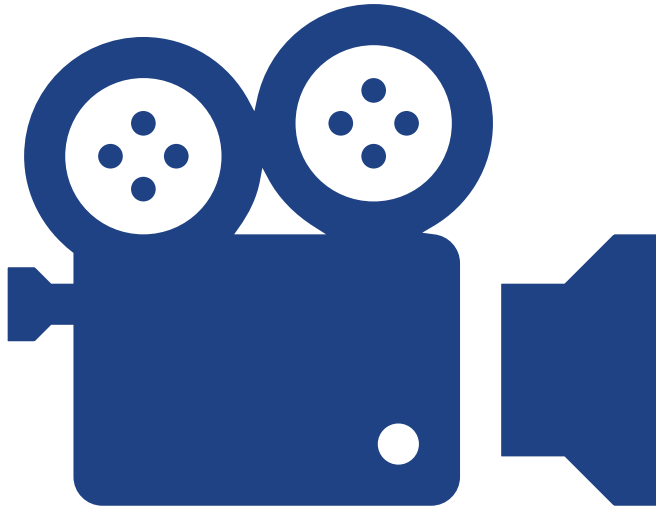

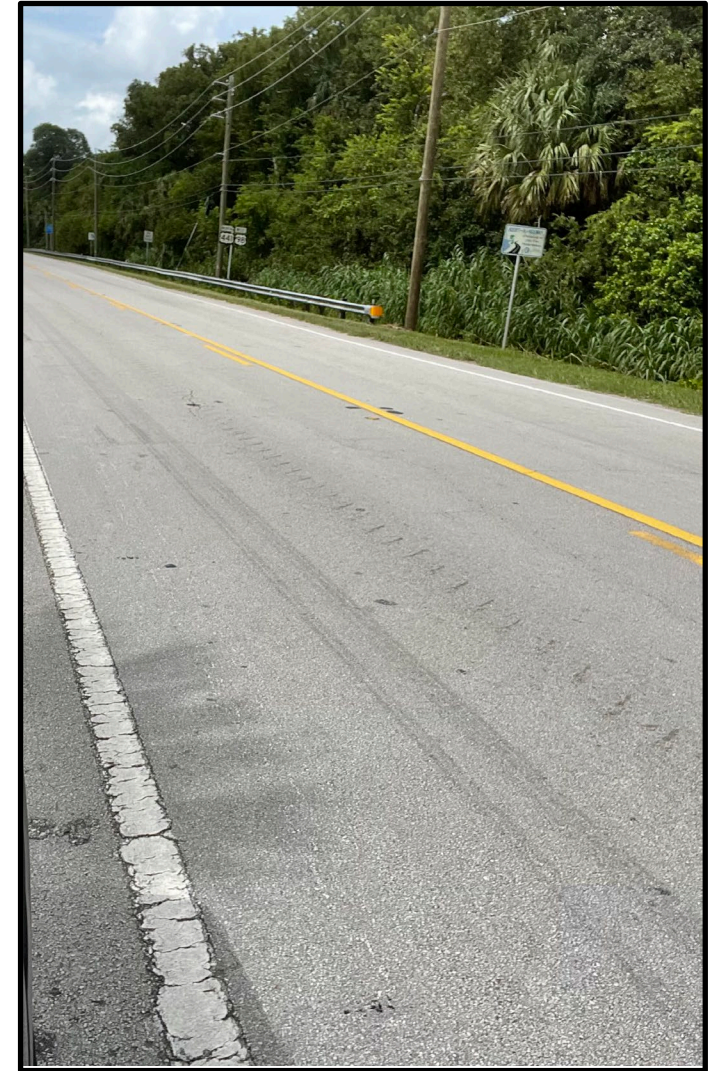

Project Overview

Purpose: Mill and resurface the existing roadway, widen the roadway shoulders to 12 feet (7 feet paved and 5 feet unpaved) and install new pavement markings.

Length: 12.333 miles

Contractor: Ranger Construction Industries, Inc.

Construction Start: August 4, 2023

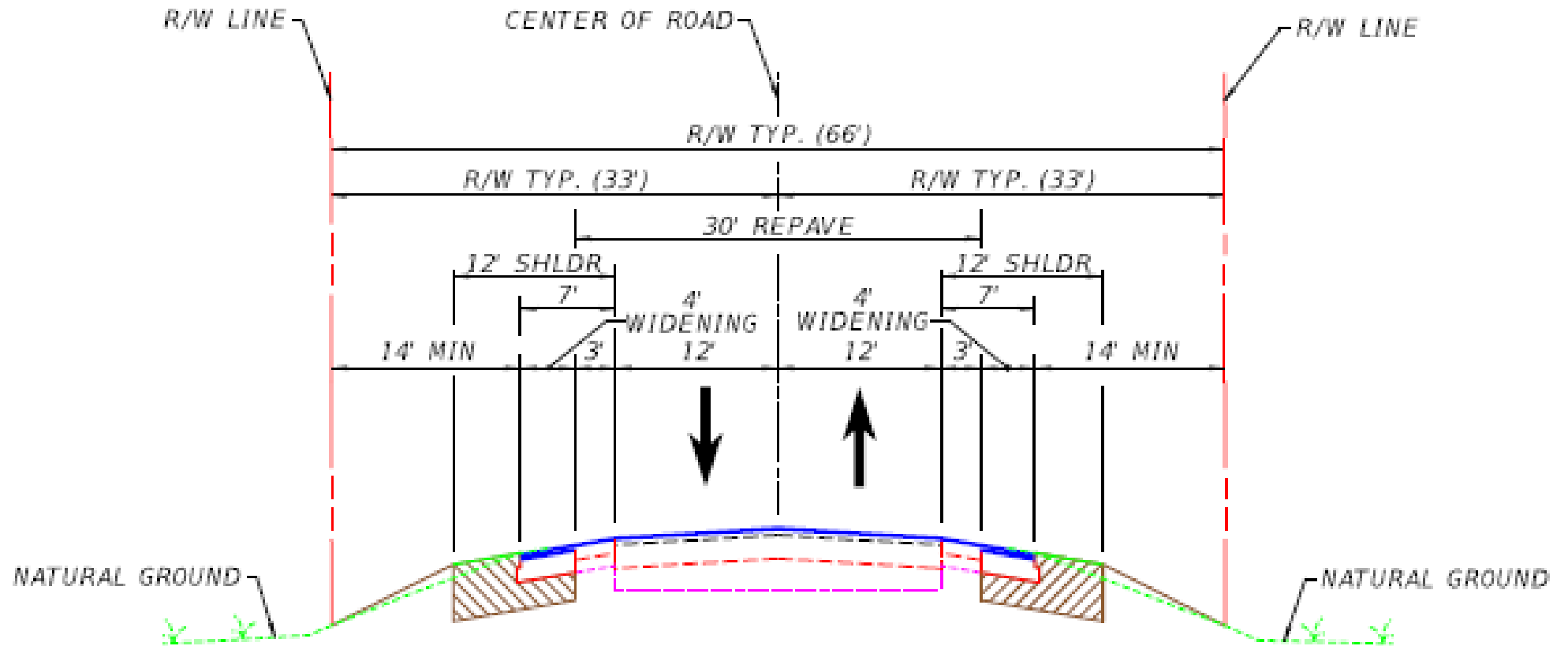
Roadway Improvements

- Installing new pavement markings

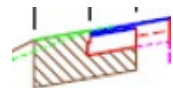


Northbound SR 15 US 98
(pre-construction)

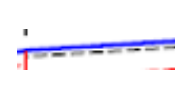
Typical Section

Maintenance of Traffic

- Single lane closures on SR 15/US 98 are permitted at any time except as follows:
 - No existing lane shall be closed at night within the project limits adjacent to residential properties
 - No existing lane shall be closed on Friday nights

Maintenance of Traffic Continued

- No flagging operations are permitted at night
- No existing side street or driveway access is permitted to be closed during construction
- No construction activities are permitted at bus stop locations during school drop off/pick up times

Construction Phasing

Phase 1 - Widen the southbound shoulders, construct guardrail and pave side streets

Phase 2 - Widen the northbound shoulder, construct guardrail, and pave side streets

Phase 3 – Mill and resurface the southbound lanes and existing shoulders

Construction Phasing

Phase 4 - Mill and resurface southbound right turn lanes and new shoulders

Phase 5 – Mill and resurface the northbound lanes and existing shoulders

Phase 6 – Mill and resurface the northbound lanes and new shoulders

Phase 7 – Mill and resurface the southbound lanes and turn lanes

Safety and Local Coordination

- **Public Safety is our Top Priority!**
 - **Work Zone Signage & Maintenance of Traffic**
 - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public
 - **Local Agency & Stakeholder Coordination**
 - The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
 - **Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times**

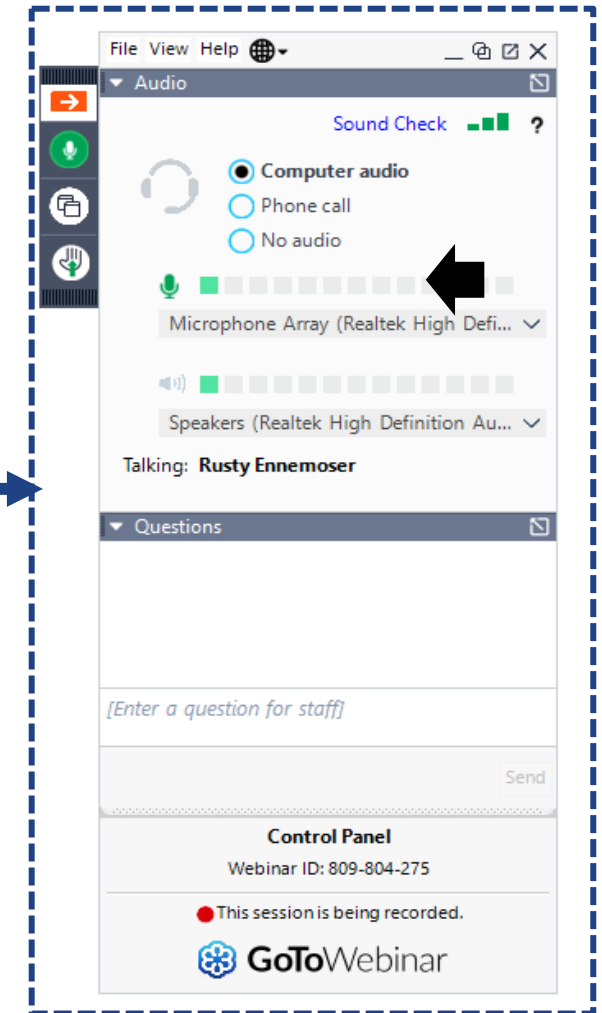
