County Road (CR) 619/82nd Avenue from 26th Street to CR 510/Wabasso Road
Indian River County, Florida

Financial Project ID: 230879-2-52-01 (North Project) and 230879-3-52-01 (South Project)

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a public information meeting regarding the proposed roadway construction along 82 Avenue (Ave.). This public meeting will be offered in two different formats, virtual and in-person, with representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by emailing the Project Manager. The presentation will start at 5:30 p.m. followed by an open discussion session. PROJECT BENEFITS

- Will provide a new north-south connection between State Road (SR) 60 and CR 510 with one continuous roadway implemented by two separate projects– North and South.
- Provide congestion relief on parallel roads and Interstate 95.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- The South Project replaces 82nd Avenue with a new two-lane road just east of the existing road from 26th Street to 69th Street. The new road consists of two 12-foot wide lanes, 8-foot wide shoulders, and a 10-foot shared-use path along the east side of the new roadway.
- The North Project is a new two-lane road connecting 69th Street to CR 510. North Project includes 12-foot wide lanes, bicycle lanes along the 8-foot wide shoulders, and a 5-foot sidewalk along the east side of the roadway.
- Addition of new drainage system including inlets, swales, and ponds.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on the existing road while new road is being built.
- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.
- Existing driveway access will be maintained throughout construction.

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- **Estimated Construction Cost:** Approximately \$10.6 million for North Project and approximately \$29.3 million for South Project.

Construction Start Date: TBD; Project is currently not programmed for construction.

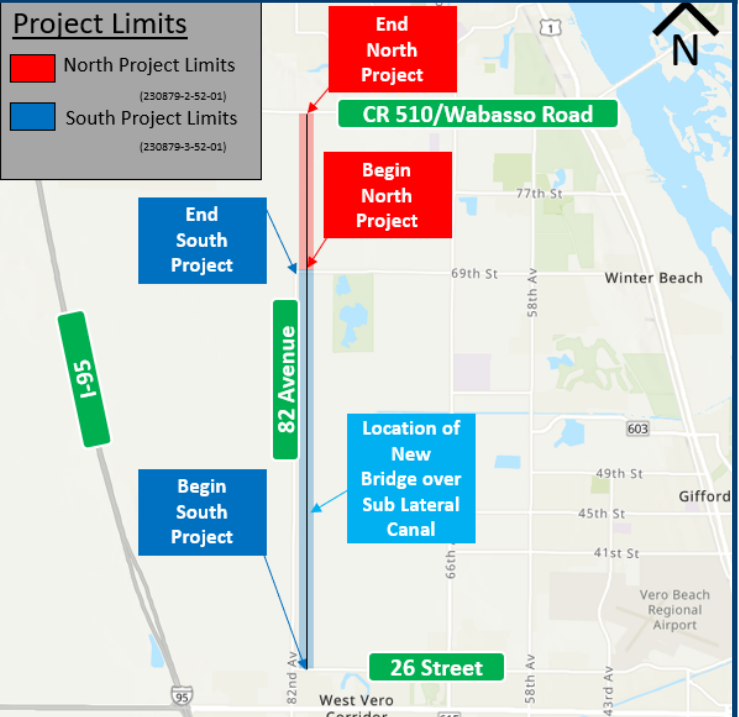
