The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 716/Southeast Port St. Lucie Boulevard Bridge Rehabilitation Project in the City of Port St. Lucie. The project limits are on SR 716/Southeast Port St. Lucie Boulevard from west of the Long Creek River to east of the North Fork Bridge over the St. Lucie River. This project aims to enhance the resiliency and longevity of the infrastructure within our communities. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$2.6 Million **Construction Start:** January 2025 **Estimated Completion:** Late 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstructing the east and west seawalls to enhance resiliency and longevity of the structures
- Performing concrete repairs to the bridges at various locations to improve resiliency and longevity

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will be performed from barges within the waterway
- Single-lane closures in one direction on SR 716/Southeast Port St. Lucie Boulevard are permitted for up to three consecutive hours at one time
- The channel will remain open to marine traffic for the duration of construction

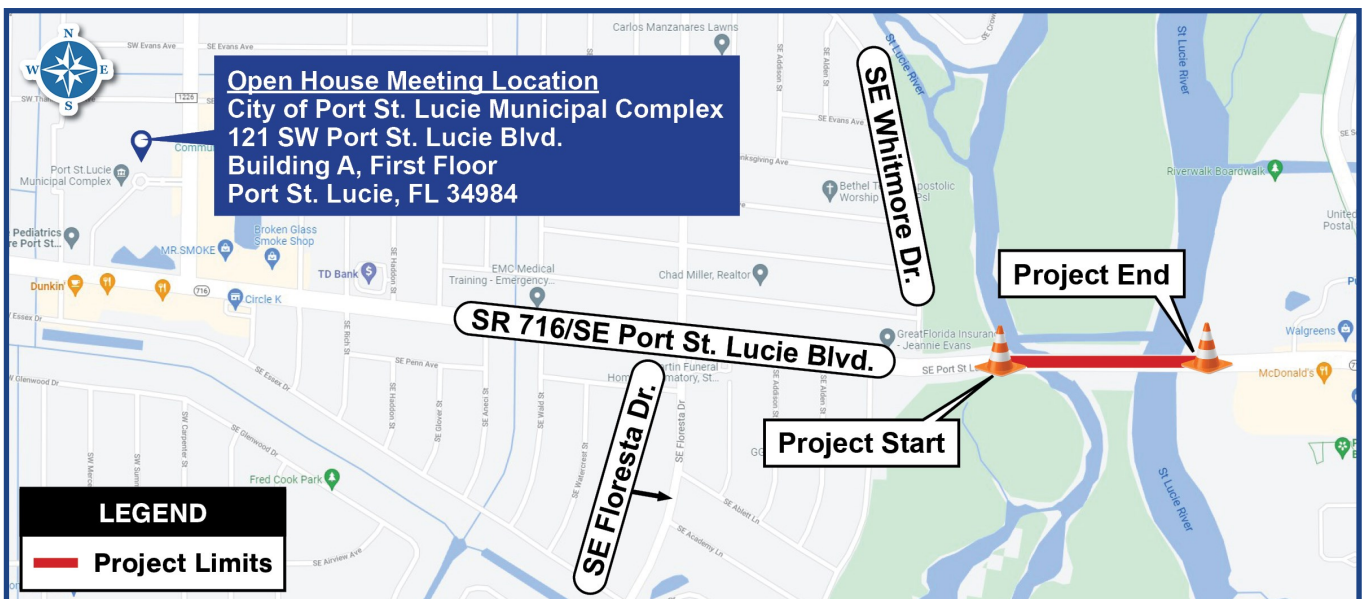
