PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to enhance long-term resilience
- Upgrading bus shelter pads along the project limits to enhance mobility and accessibility
- Upgrading existing pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to improve push button accessibility
- Upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and connectivity


