
NEW SR 9/I-95 NORTHBOUND MANAGED LANE TRAFFIC PATTERN:

The SR 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes, which previously ended at SR 848/Stirling Road, were extended approximately 550 feet to just north of SR 818/Griffin Road on the morning of July 15, 2025. Motorists must exit the managed lanes north of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to access SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 848/Stirling Road, or SR 818/Griffin Road. This extension enhances lane continuity and safety.

Overhead signage has been updated to reflect the new exit pattern: Local Exits 21–29 & Sheridan St thru Griffin Rd.

The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
