S.R. A1A RRR PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Public Meeting regarding the upcoming S.R. A1A RRR Project in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$2,638,158

Construction Start: January 2026

Estimated Completion: Fall 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience.
- Replacing crosswalk at various location within the project limits.
- Installing in-pavement lighting at the Hibiscus Avenue Crosswalk.
- Upgrading existing pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to enhance pedestrian safety.
- Upgrading concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and accessibility.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along S.R. A1A are permitted, as needed, Sunday night through Friday morning, 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Traffic shifts will occur for crosswalk reconstruction activities.
- Motorists and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
