State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

#### NORTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 BETWEEN S.R. 818/GRIFFIN ROAD AND S.R. 84 TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT WEDNESDAY, FEB. 18

Northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Full Closure Notice: All lanes of northbound S.R. 9/I-95 between S.R. 818/Griffin Road and S.R. 84 will be closed to traffic overnight from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 18. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install detection loops. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During the full closure, northbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road, northbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5, and westbound S.R. 862/I-595 to access ramps to northbound S.R. 9/I-95.

To ensure community and public safety, the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from S.R. 818/Griffin Road will also be closed. Motorists travelling within the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard and will be able to re-enter the Express Lanes at S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard. Thursday, Feb. 19 and Sunday, Feb. 22 will be used as contingency nights if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
