Northbound NW 1st Avenue at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard to close nightly as needed, Feb. 1—5

Northbound NW 1st Avenue at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 7 a.m., beginning Sunday, Feb. 1, 2026 through Thursday, Feb. 5, 2026, for drainage and roadway reconstruction work. Motorists traveling westbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be detoured via northbound S.R. 845/Powerline Road/NW 9th Avenue, eastbound NW 13th Street, and northbound NW 1st Avenue. Motorists traveling eastbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be detoured via northbound N. Andrews Avenue, westbound NW 13th Street, and northbound NW 1st Avenue. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
