SR 93/I-75 AT ROYAL PALM BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide the community with information regarding the S.R. 93/I-75 at Royal Palm Boulevard Interchange Improvements Project from S.R. 818/Griffin Road to SW 14th Street in the towns of Southwest Ranches and Davie, and the City of Weston. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$36.2 Million

Construction Start: September 2025

Estimated Completion: Summer 2028

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening the S.R. 93/I-75 mainline to add an additional lane and enhance entry and exit movements
- Widening the S.R. 93/I-75 exit and entrance ramps at Royal Palm Boulevard and S.R. 818/Griffin Road to increase storage capacity and enhance traffic flow
- Widening the S.R. 93/I-75 bridge over the C-11 Canal to support the S.R. 93/I-75 mainline expansion and enhance traffic flow
- Installing Wrong-Way Driver Detect on Systems at key locations to enhance safety:
 - Southbound S.R. 93/I-75 exit ramp to westbound Royal Palm Boulevard
 - Northbound S.R. 93/I-75 exit ramp to westbound Royal Palm Boulevard
 - Northbound S.R. 93/I-75 exit ramp to westbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings within the project limits to enhance nighttime visibility
- Upgrading existing light poles with new LED fixtures and installing additional poles throughout the project limits to enhance nighttime visibility

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures on S.R. 93/I-75 mainline and ramps are permitted nightly as needed, 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Lane closures on Royal Palm Boulevard are permitted nightly as needed, 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Full closures of S.R. 93/I-75 mainline and ramps with detours are permitted nightly as needed, for paving and overhead sign structure operations, 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Shoulder closures are permitted as needed

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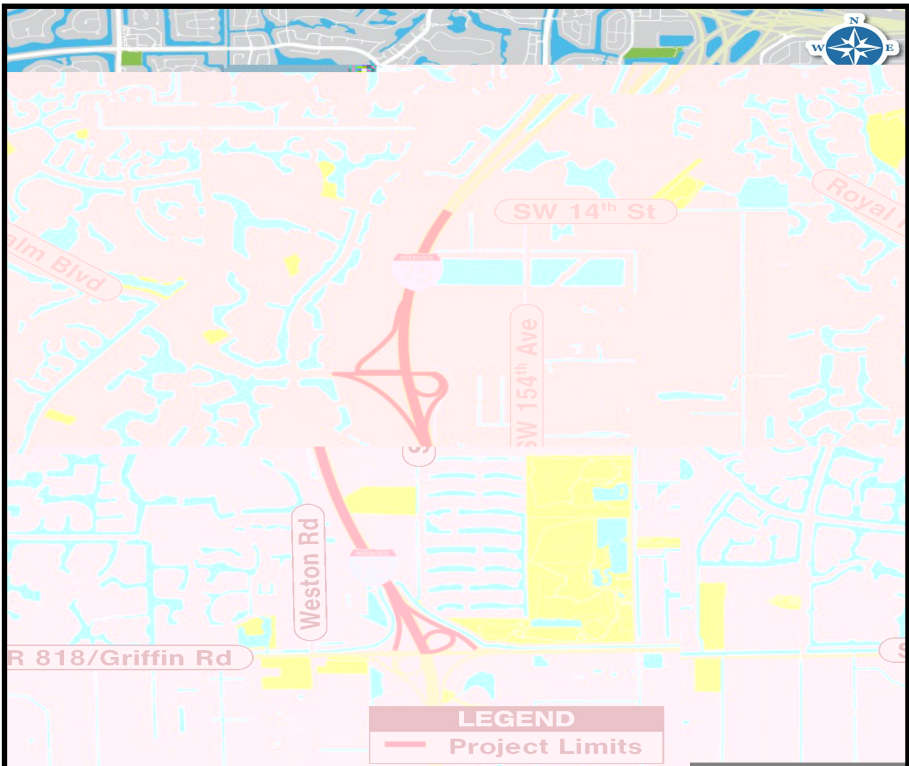
