### Southbound NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard to close overnight Wednesday, Jan. 28

Southbound NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic overnight, from 9 p.m. until 7 a.m., on Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2026, for paving operations. NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue traffic will be detoured via westbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, southbound N. Andrews Avenue, eastbound NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street, and southbound NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Thursday, Jan. 29 and Friday, Jan. 30 will be used as contingency nights if needed. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
