The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the SR 848/Stirling Road Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project with limits on SR 848/Stirling Road from west of N. 58th Avenue to SR 5/US 1/N. Federal Highway in the Cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$9,269,118

Construction Start: July 2024

Estimated Completion: Fall 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Modifying the median traffic separator to accommodate 11-foot turn lanes within the project limits
- Installing new mast arms on SR 848/Stirling Road at the intersections of N. Park Road, SW 33rd Avenue, and J.A. Ely Boulevard
- Upgrading technology including pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to improve push button accessibility
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings within project limits to enhance nighttime visibility

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

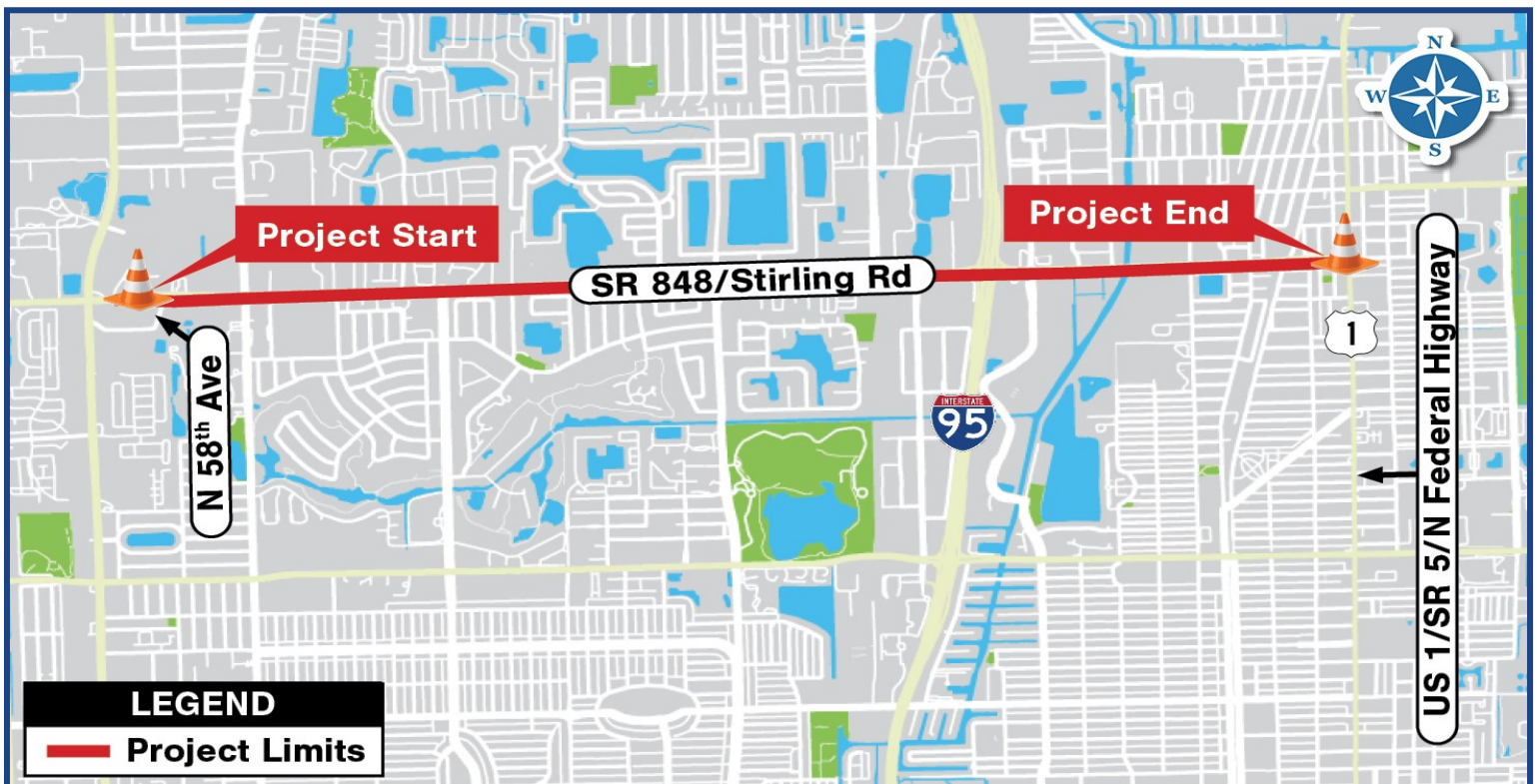
