

BASS CREEK ROAD AT SW 148TH AVENUE WILL UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE JANUARY 3, 2023 THROUGH MARCH 10, 2023

Bass Creek Road at SW 148th Avenue will be closed Jan. 3 beginning at 9 a.m. through March 10 until 3:30 p.m. for the construction of the roundabout. Motorists traveling northbound wishing to access Bass Creek Road will be detoured via SW 148th Avenue and Lakeside Drive. Motorists traveling eastbound on Bass Creek Road will be detoured via Lakeside Drive and SW 148th Avenue. Signage will be in place to direct motorists.

Construction Cost: \$1,967,721 Construction Start: July 2022 Estimated Completion: Early 2023



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Miramar, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the Bass Creek Road Roundabout Improvements Project through the City of Miramar Resolution No. 16-01. Scope of work includes constructing a roundabout at the intersection of SW 148th Avenue and Bass Creek Road, constructing a shared-use path on the east side of SW 148th Avenue within the project limits, milling and resurfacing SW 148th Avenue within the project limits, minor roadway widening along SW 148th Avenue, upgrading signing and pavement markings, and installing new light poles.
