# I-95 Southbound Entrance Ramp from Stirling Road and Stirling Road Eastbound Lane Will Be Closed Nightly, Beginning Jan. 16

As part of 95 Express Phase 3C, the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., and the eastbound outside lane on Stirling Road, just west of the I-95 overpass, will be closed to traffic nightly, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday night Jan. 16 through Thursday night, Jan. 27. This closure will occur so crews can safely perform concrete and grout pour operations. During this operation, motorists traveling westbound wishing to access I-95 southbound will be detoured via Stirling Road westbound, US 441 southbound, and Sheridan Street eastbound to the I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound wishing to access I-95 southbound will be detoured via Stirling Road eastbound, US 1 southbound, and Sheridan Street westbound to the I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the north sidewalk along Stirling Road. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.
