Project Scope

- Widening the eastbound approach on Oakes Road to provide dual left turn lanes and an exclusive right turn lane
- Striping of buffered bicycle lanes along southbound SR 7 between I-595 and the eastbound off-ramp to Oakes Road
- Milling and resurfacing
- Reconstructing existing sidewalk and curb ramps to meet ADA standards
- Improvements to drainage, lighting, signalization and pavement markings.

• Construction Completion: Fall 2023


• Construction Cost Estimate: \$2.5 Million




Existing Roadway- SR-7






Existing Roadway- Oakes Rd.






Proposed Roadway- SR-7

- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.


