#### SR 842/BROWARD BOULEVARD RESURFACING PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the upcoming roadway improvements along SR 842/Broward Boulevard within the cities of Fort Lauderdale, Plantation, and Lauderhill.

Construction Cost: \$7,262,972

Construction Start: July 2023

Estimated Completion: Fall 2024

### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Upgrading pedestrian signals at all signalized intersections within the project limits
- Installing 39 light poles and upgrading existing lighting with LED fixtures between US 441/SR 7 and W 27th Avenue
- Removing decorative paver crosswalks
- Extending median left turn lanes to increase vehicle capacity at various locations
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings


# TRAFFIC IMPACTS
