Partial Closure at the Intersection of Broward Boulevard and N Federal Highway Beginning Friday Night, February 19 through Monday Morning, February 22

The intersection at Broward Boulevard and N Federal Highway will be partially closed Friday, February 19, beginning at 9:30 p.m. until Monday, February 22 at 6 a.m., for the removal of existing brick pavers. Motorists traveling eastbound on Broward Boulevard will be detoured via NE 3rd Avenue, NE 4th Street, and NE 11th Street. Motorists traveling westbound on Broward Boulevard will be detoured via NE 7th Avenue, NE 4th Avenue, and NE 3rd Avenue. Motorists will be able to travel northbound and southbound along N Federal Highway during this operation.



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The improvements associated with this project include replacing the existing brick pavers with asphalt and upgrading signing and pavement markings at the following intersections: NW/SW 7th Avenue/Avenue of the Arts, N/S Andrews Avenue, NE/SE 3rd Avenue and SR 5/US-1/N Federal Highway. It also includes upgrading roadway lighting at the following intersections: NW/SW 7th Avenue/Avenue of the Arts, NW/SW 5th Avenue, NW/SW 1st Avenue, N/S Andrews Avenue and NE/SE 3rd Avenue.
