SR-5 (US-1) Bridge over Dania Cut-off Canal Rehabilitation Project
Broward County, Florida

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding the rehabilitation of SR-5 (US-1) bridge over the Dania Cut-off Canal. No public information workshop is scheduled for this project.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Replace the existing navigation/marine fenders, including replacement of the timber piles and walers (components of the bridge structure).
- Rehabilitate the existing slope at the southwest corner of the bridge.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will take place during the day and be sequenced to reduce the effects of construction on the community.
- The bridge will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic for the duration of construction. However, lane closures along Old Griffin Rd will be required for pile driving activities on the west side of the bridge for a period not to exceed three consecutive weeks. A temporary detour will be provided.
- Marine traffic may be impacted. Temporary channel closures may be required while driving the fender piles in place. Notifications will be sent out to marinas and homeowners with waterfront access upstream of the Dania Canal, a minimum of 14 calendar days prior to clo-

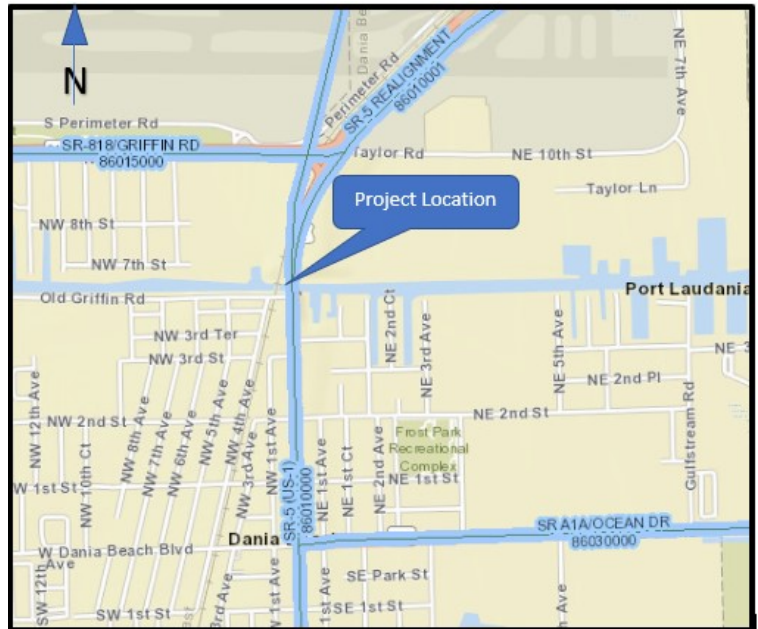
