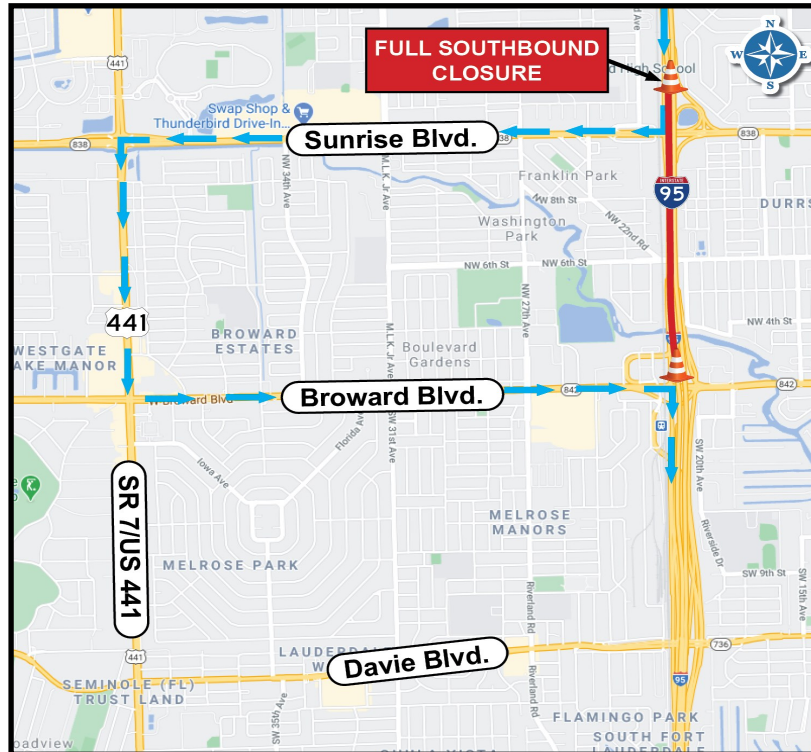
I-95 from Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard

I-95 Southbound lanes at Sunrise Boulevard to Close Overnight March 15 & 16

I-95 southbound lanes at Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic overnight Monday night, March 15 and Tuesday night, March 16 for overhead sign structure removal. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m. and all lanes will be closed by 11:30 p.m., reopening by 5:30 a.m. each morning. Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard, US-441 /SR-7 and Broward Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.



This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes north from just south of Broward Boulevard to just north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County, to include two Managed Lanes in each direction. Scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes, ramp reconstructions, bridge widenings, ramp signalization, installation of noise barrier walls along I-95 northbound and southbound, guardrail, barrier wall, drainage, landscape relocation, and ITS installation.
