SR-838/SUNRISE BOULEVARD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding the intersection improvements on SR-838/Sunrise Boulevard from SR-5/US-1 to east of NE 10th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Construction Cost: \$1.8 million

Construction Start Date: late-August 2022

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening the roadway to accommodate an additional westbound left turn lane at the intersection of SR-838/Sunrise Boulevard and SR-5/US-1
- Modifying the median between NE 9th Street and SR-838/Sunrise Boulevard
- Upgrading traffic signals at the intersection of SR-838/Sunrise Boulevard and SR-5/US-1
- Roadway milling and resurfacing of the project limits
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Temporary lane closures may occur from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- A detour will be in place as needed, from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., during traffic signal operations at SR-838/Sunrise Boulevard and SR-5/US-1.
- Access to private properties will be maintained at all times during construction.
