The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting for the resurfacing, restoration and rehabilitation (RRR) project on SR 822/ Sheridan Street from N 22nd Avenue to SR 5/US-1/ S Federal Highway in the cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach.

Construction Cost: \$893,624

Construction Start: March 29, 2021

Estimated Completion: Fall 2021

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Modifying three medians; please see map below
- Upgrading pedestrian signals and lighting at N Dixie Highway and N 21st Avenue
- Upgrading sidewalks and curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures will occur nightly, 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- One lane may be closed in one direction daily, 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., weekdays and weekends.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Additional lane closure information will be provided in the Weekly Traffic Report distributed by FDOT.
