



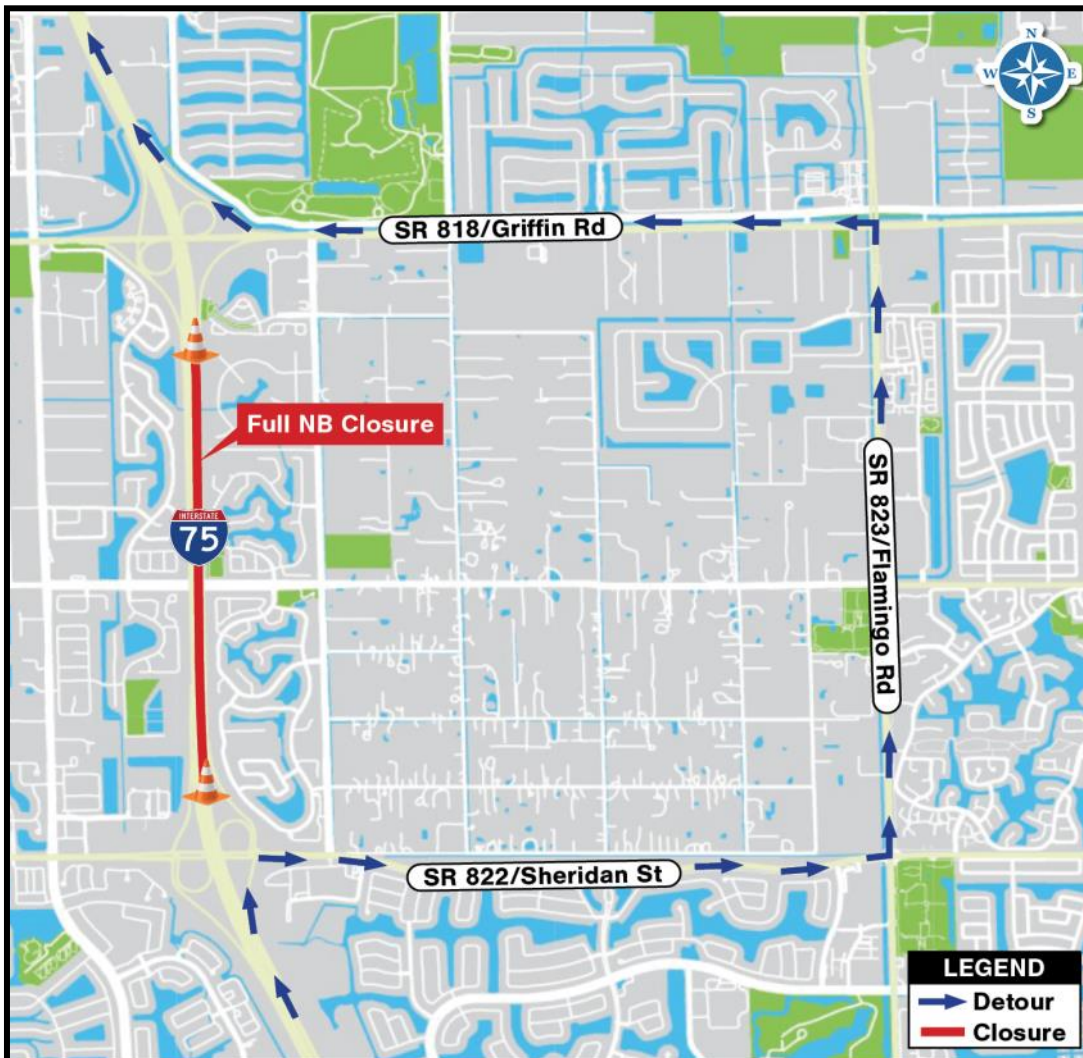

SR 93/I-75 NORTHBOUND BETWEEN SR 822/SHERIDAN STREET AND SR 818/GRIFFIN ROAD TO CLOSE MONDAY, MARCH 18

All lanes of SR 93/I-75 northbound between SR 822/Sheridan Street and SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Monday night, March 18 for overhead sign structure installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via the SR 93/I-75 northbound exit ramp to SR 822/ Sheridan Street eastbound, SR 823/Flamingo Road northbound, and SR 818/Griffin Road westbound to the SR 93/I-75 northbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling north on the SR 93/I-75 northbound Managed Lanes will be detoured via SR 93/I-75 northbound mainline at the SR 820/Pines Boulevard egress ramp. Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite to assist motorists. Tuesday, March 19 will be used as contingency nights if needed.



Improvements as part of this project include roadway widening to provide continuous auxiliary lanes and 10-foot shoulders in each direction of SR 93/I-75, repaving and restriping the existing asphalt, replacing overhead signage, installing new guardrail in each direction of SR 93/I-75, and updating drainage, lighting, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS).
