STATE ROAD 9/I-95 AT COPANS ROAD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information about interstate improvements at SR 9/I-95 at the Copans Road interchange in the City of Pompano Beach.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a dedicated merge lane for I-95 northbound traffic from Copans Road that is physically separated from the I-95 general purposes lanes
- Constructing a parallel road for I-95 southbound traffic entering and exiting onto Copans Road
- · Constructing noise walls
- Installing drainage and landscaping
- Updating the lighting and intelligent transportation system (ITS)
- Roadway widening, milling, resurfacing, signage and pavement markings, sidewalk, and curb and gutter

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur on Copans Road, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Lane closures may occur on Copans Road, from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Friday
- At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction of Copans Road at all times
- I-95 lane closures:
- One to two lanes may be closed, from 9:30 p.m. to
 5:30 a.m., Sunday though Thursday
- * Three or more lanes may be closed from 12:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- I-95 ramps may be closed from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times
