

HILLSBORO BOULEVARD BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN DEERFIELD BEACH

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$594,926.74 contract to Sea Coast Inc. to improve the Hillsboro Boulevard Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway in Deerfield Beach. Construction will begin April1, 2016 and is expected to be completed in summer 2016.

Project Limits

Hillsboro Boulevard Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway

Project Improvements

- Adding new bicycle friendly riding surface plates to the outside lane of the bridge in each direction
- Replacing the aluminum textured sidewalk plates on both sides of the bridge to provide an improved walking surface
- Improving existing maintenance hatches and platforms on the bridge
- Improving the existing span locks



Traffic Impact

Crews will work on the westbound lanes first, followed by the eastbound lanes. The contractor plans to work Mondays through Fridays with one outside lane closed between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Updates will be included in the weekly traffic report.
