US 441/SR 7 AT OAKES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the SR 7/US 441 at Oakes Road Intersection Improvements Project in the City of Davie.

Construction Cost: \$2,144,350

Construction Start: September 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening the eastbound approach on Oakes Road to provide dual left turn lanes and an exclusive right turn lane
- Striping 7-foot buffered bicycle lanes along southbound SR 7/US 441 between Oakes Road and south of the I-595 interchange
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits
- Upgrading lighting, signing and pavement markings
- Upgrading the existing signalizations to mast arms

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Nightly lane closures will occur Sunday through Thursday, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., for paving operations.
- Single lane closures may occur daily, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

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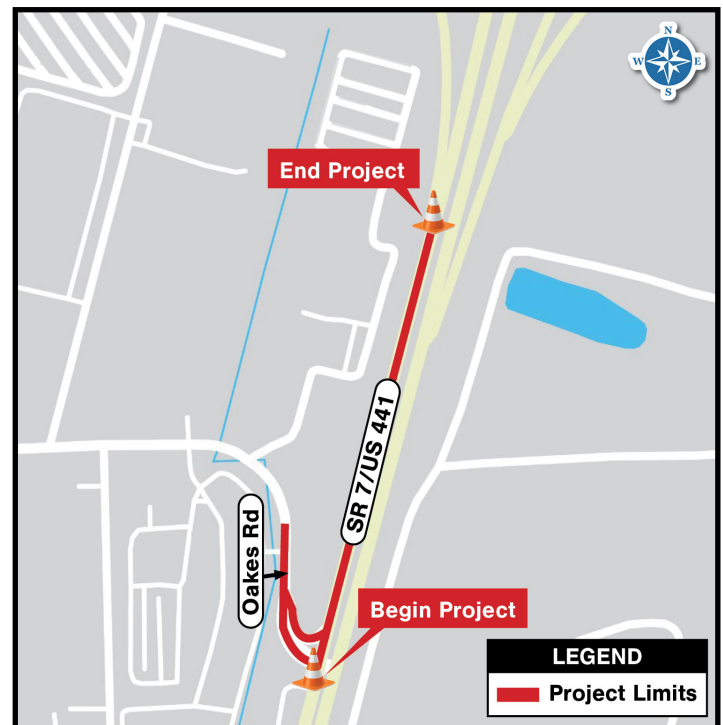
