The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Virtual Public Meeting regarding the proposed improvements within the City of Plantation along University Drive from Westbound SR 84 to NW 1 Street. ### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Accommodate bicycle lanes by resurfacing and widening the existing roadway
- Construct incidental drainage due to the proposed widening
- Construct curb, gutter, and sidewalks
- Upgrade curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Construct bus shelters at existing bus stop locations
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings
- Upgrade four signalized intersections to pedestrian countdown signals:
  - SR 817/University Drive and Peters Road
  - SR 817/University Drive at The Fountains Entrance
  - SR 817/University Drive and Federated Road
  - SR 817/University Drive and SR 842/Broward Boulevard
- Replace light poles impacted by proposed widening and improve lighting uniformity levels on the sidewalk, including pedestrian lighting retrofit at the signalized intersections of:
  - SR 817/University Drive at Westbound SR 84
  - SR 817/University Drive at The Fountains Entrance
  - SR 817/University Drive and Federated Road
  - SR 817/University Drive and SR 842/Broward Boulevard

### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Resurfacing will be performed at night
- Work will be phased to reduce impacts to the community
- Lane closures are anticipated; however, no full roadway Closure will be required

- Construction Start Date: **Spring 2022**
- Anticipated Completion: **Fall 2023**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$ 9.1 Million**

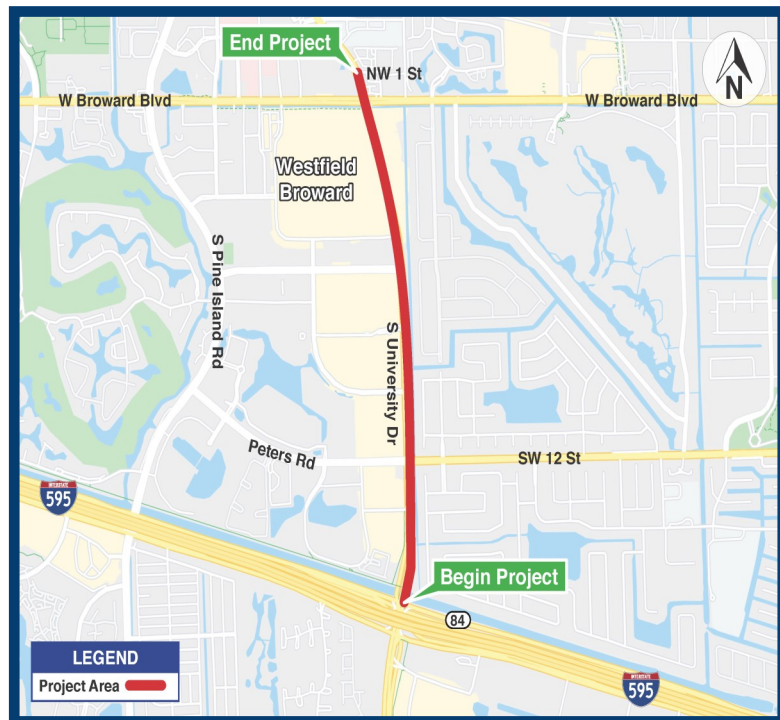
