### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECT NOTICE: BRIDGE DIVERSION**

#### 95 EXPRESS LANES PHASE 3C PROJECT

I-95 from South of Hollywood Boulevard to South of Broward Boulevard & I-595 from West of SR 7 to I-95 Broward County, Florida

#### SR 84 WESTBOUND BRIDGE OVER I-95 TO BE DIVERTED FOR RECONSTRUCTION THROUGH SPRING 2022

To ensure motorist and pedestrian safety, the SR 84 westbound bridge over I-95 will be diverted for reconstruction beginning May 8, 2021 through spring 2022. SR 84 westbound traffic will be diverted to the eastbound bridge via newly built crossovers, where two lanes in each direction will be maintained. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout bridge reconstruction via a newly constructed designated sidewalk. Additional full ramp closures will be implemented with this activity to ensure motorists safety during construction.

- Motorists traveling SR 84 westbound wishing to access I-95 southbound will be diverted along the eastbound bridge, make a U-turn at SW 26th Terrace, continue eastbound on SR 84 to access the I-95 southbound entrance ramp. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 84 eastbound will be maintained.
- Motorists traveling **SR 84 eastbound** wishing to access I-95 northbound will be diverted to a U-turn at SW 15th Avenue and continue westbound on SR 84 to access the I-95 northbound entrance ramp. The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 84 westbound will be maintained; signage will be placed to advise motorists.
- Motorists traveling on I-95 southbound wishing to access the SR 84 eastbound ramp will be diverted to the SR 84 westbound movement. Motorists will continue on SR 84 westbound, make a U-turn at SW 26th Terrace and continue eastbound on SR 84; signage will be placed to advise motorists.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the eastbound bridge via a temporary sidewalk which will be implemented before the SR 84 westbound bridge closes.

# RAMP TO BE CLOSED IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE SR 84 WESTBOUND BRIDGE CLOSURE THROUGH SPRING 2022

#### THE I-95 NORTHBOUND EXIT RAMP TO SR 84 TO CLOSE THROUGH SPRING 2022.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 84 will be closed to traffic beginning, May 8, 2021 through spring 2022 for bridge work operations. Motorists traveling on I-95 northbound wishing to access SR 84 east of I-95 will be detoured via I-595 eastbound to SR 5 (US 1) northbound and SR 84 westbound. Motorists traveling on I-95 northbound wishing to access SR 84 west of I-95 will be detoured via I-595 westbound, SR 7 (US 441) southbound and SR 84 eastbound. Signage will be in place advising motorists of the detours.

The 95 Express Lanes Phase 3C project will extend the existing Express Lanes North from just south of Hollywood Boulevard to just south of Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between 95 Express Lanes and I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of I-595 from SR 7 to I-95 and along I-95 from south of Hollywood Boulevard to south of Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, I-95/SR 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Installation, including traffic monitoring devices, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges, lighting, signage, and drainage installation and construction of shoulder—mounted sound walls and retaining walls.
