Construction Start: August 2, 2021

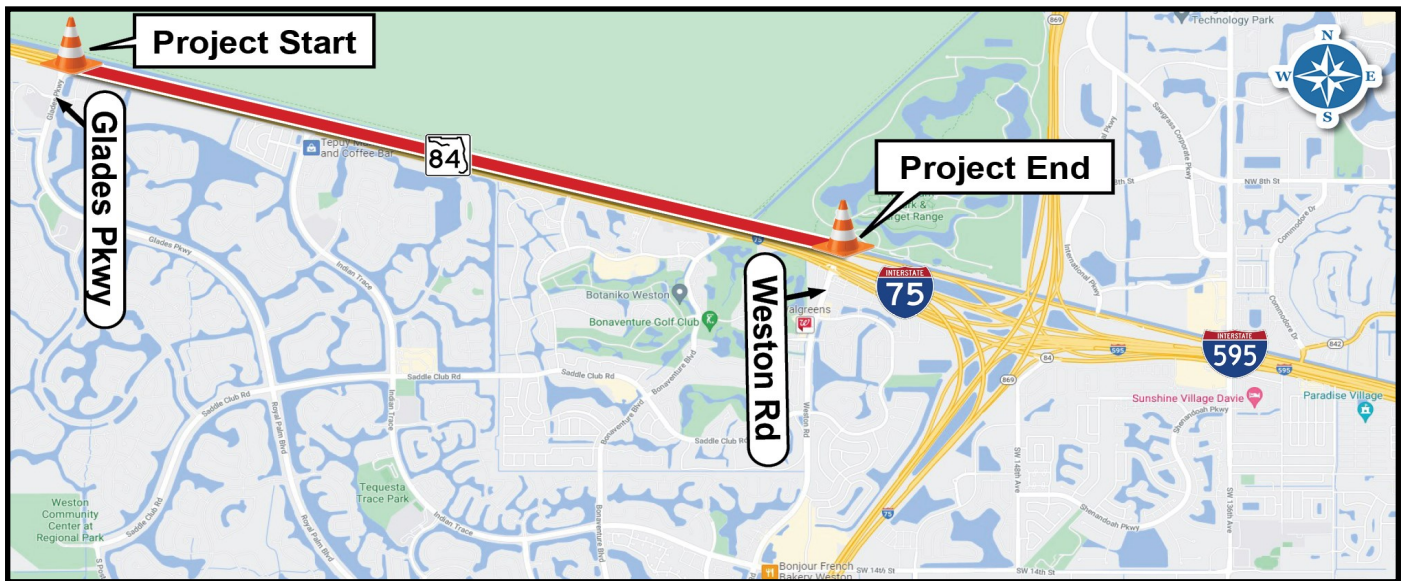
Estimated Completion: Spring 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway and replacing pavement markings
- Widening the shoulder along SR-84
- Installing bicycle lanes at Indian Trace and Glades Parkway
- Repairing guardrail as needed, along westbound SR-84

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are permitted while construction activities are taking place.
- SR-84 entrance and exit ramp closures are permitted between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night.
- Additional information about lane closures and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
