



A1A SIDEWALK AND LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN HALLANDALE BEACH

Project Overview

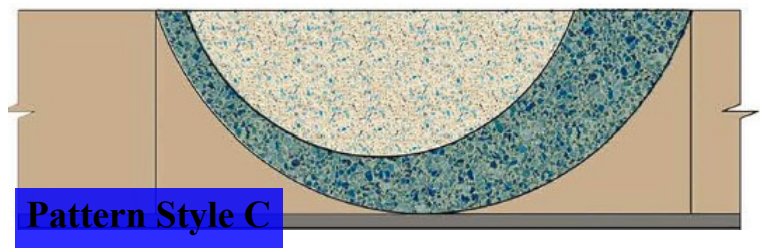
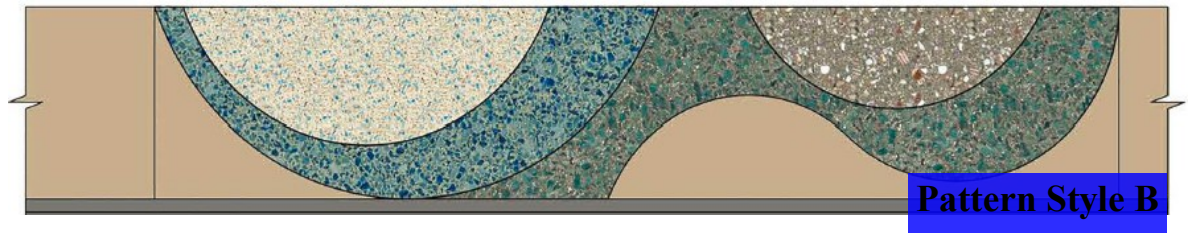
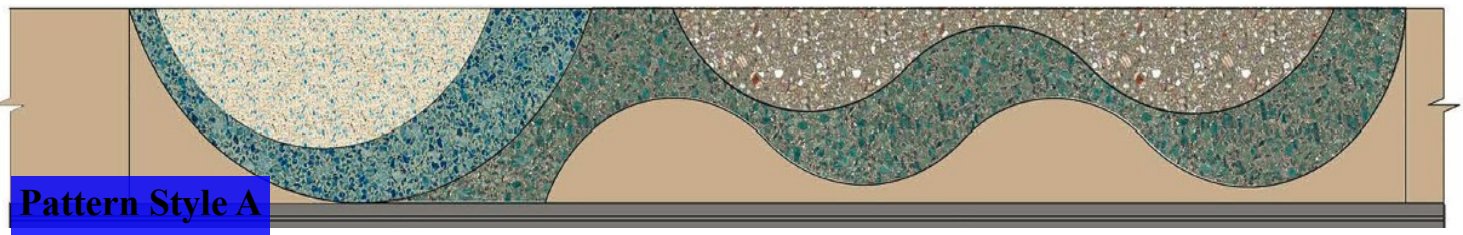
The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$2.9 million contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. to make sidewalk and lighting improvements along A1A, from the County Line Road to Hallandale Beach Boulevard. The length of the project is 0.8 miles. Construction will begin in August 2016 and is expected to be completed by Summer 2017.

Project Improvements

- Installation of new decorative sidewalk
- Installation of new decorative street and pedestrian lighting

Traffic Impact

- One lane in each direction of A1A of the intersection Hallandale Beach Boulevard may be closed Monday through Thursday between the hours of 7:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m. (except when pouring sidewalk, one lane can be closed until 8:30 a.m.)
- Sidewalks on both sides of A1A will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday. Signs will be in place to direct pedestrians to sidewalk detours.
